Without doubt these long term members of staff have been part of our community for many years and I am pleased to say they will stay part of the community for many more years in some form. Over the next coming weeks, staff will be holding a collection box in the playground for collections for their leaving presents from the community if you wish to contribute. On Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July, between 2pm and 3pm the ladies will be in the garden at the back of the wellbeing house, relaxing I hope as they contemplate their retirement. As parents if you wish to say goodbye personally, the gates will be open between 2pm and 3pm for you to say your goodbyes.

We are excited to inform you that we are investing in more teachers to join Dorrington Academy as we have a program of catch up for all the education the children have missed during Covid restrictions.
