Computing

This term, we will be learning about programming. We will be learning how to move a BeeBot robot.

Art

We will develop our painting techniques exploring different line works such as dots, dashes, faint lines and bold lines. We will be mixing primary colours to create secondary colours and creating different thickness of paint by adding water.

Phonics

We will continue to learn the Set 2 sounds.

These consist of two or three letters which represent one sound.

English

During this half term, we will read the book 'The Jolly Postman'. Using the book, the children will retrieve and infer information about the characters. The children will also look at identify nouns and verbs and using those to write their own sentences.

In addition, they will be focusing on using the correct letter formation and size and explore the use of capital letters.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on reading, writing and interpreting mathematical statements involving addition, subtraction and equals. The children will continue to focus on building the foundations of numbers within 20. We will also represent and use number bonds and related subtraction within 20. We will also learn to mentally add and subtract one and two-digit numbers to 20 including zero.

Geography

We will be exploring the local and geographical features of the local area using aerial photographs to identify key landmarks and human and physical features. We will take part in a walk around our local area. We will be creating a map of what we have explored.



<u>Music</u>

This half term, the children will be focusing on learning songs for the Christmas production, using clear diction, singing voices and the correct pitch.

Physical Education

In P.E, we will be developing our object control skills - underarm and overarm throws, passing and catching small objects/balls. We will also develop our gymnastic skills. We will learn how to balance on different body parts and copy simple sequences.

Within this half term, we will be learning what a good friend means and what it means to work well within a group. We will also be recognising that friends can affect the way we feel and everyone has different emotions.

History

We will explore changes within our living memory. Children will delve deeper back in time to understand the concepts of the past and of historical enquiry – exploring the history of the local area; looking at what was in place before our school and more recent changes)describing the similarities and differences). We will use common phrases related to the passing of time whilst asking questions from photographs and maps.

Science / Outdoor Education

This term we will continue to look at the topic animals including humans. We will explore nocturnal animals and their characteristics. Children will look at minibeasts, labelling and identifying the important features of their body parts.
