Computing

This term, the children will learn to effectively use the World Wide Web and the internet to search. They will learn how to using online platforms respectfully and responsibly.

<u>Art</u>

We will be exploring the use of colour, lines, shape and layering through observational drawings. We will be developing our confidence using different mediums and textures to represent the sea, waves, water and light inspired by the artist Kat Sushahika Hokusai.



Spanish

We will be learning how to describe the weather in detail. We will learn how to describe Spain and what it is famous for as well as describe the places we live in detail.

<u>Maths</u>

Over this term, we will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages. The children will be adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions as well as converting between mixed numbers and improper fractions. We will also be finding percentages of amounts and finding fraction, decimal and percentage equivalence.

Physical Education

This term, we will be learning the skills involved in Cricket. We will develop our batting, throwing, catching and bowling skills. Then we will then apply these skills into a game situation and develop simple tactics to increase our teams score.

Science / Outdoor Education

This term's topic is Animals including Humans. We will identify parts of the body which make up the system and explore what the main functions of the heart are and identify the main effects of exercise on the body and how diet affects lifestyle. We will plan and conduct an investigation on the impact of exercise on heart rate.

<u>English</u>

Over this term, we will be using the text 'Kensuke's Kingdom' to write a discussion text. They will be focusing on using modal verbs, determiners and possessive pronouns and exploring more complex sentence structures. The children will also be analysing and writing poetry focused on Flanders' Field by John McCrae. They will use imagery to convey tone.

Geography

We will be exploring continents, oceans, tropics of cancer and tropics of capricorns through our wider topic of The Mayans and Ancient Benin civilisations.
