

## Computing

This term, the children will be completing digital art using the software Microsoft Paint. We will learn how to select appropriate tools and make careful decisions.

## Art

Art this term will focus on drawing with a pencil, making different marks, such as dots, dashes, scribbles, sweeping lines, straight lines and wavy lines. The children will use this skill to produce an observational still drawing of a toy.

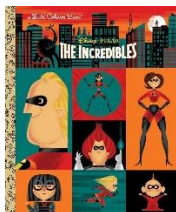
## Phonics

We will continue to learn the set 2 and set 3 sounds. These consist of two or three letter which represent one sound or letters that are split between a consonant.

## English

Over this half-term, the children will be introduced to the book 'The Incredibles'. Using the book, the children will retrieve and infer information about the characters. Children will also look at identifying words with the suffix 'est', 's' and 'es' and use these in their own sentences.

In addition, the children will be learning and understanding the rule of plurals.



## **Year 1 Curriculum Map Spring 1**

## Maths

Over this term, we will be focusing on solving one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction as well as missing number problems.

We will also be solving number problems with number and our understanding of place value. We will be looking at representing and using number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. In addition, children will also be learning to count in multiples of two, five and ten.

## Music

The focus in music this half-term is sound. The children will be exposed to a variety of different sounds used to replicate other sounds. In groups, the children will be using a variety of different sounds to plan and create their own sound journey.

## History

Children in Year 1 will be exploring family history and looking at how childhood has changed between generations. Exploring change and continuity. We will use words to show the passing of time and explore family trees and chronology using dates and sequences. We will use artefacts and photographs to help with our explanations.

## Physical Education

This half term the children will be developing their gymnastic skills by using different methods of movement/travelling and learn to balance on different body parts. We will also start to link object control skills and locomotion skills learnt earlier on in the year together.



## RESPECT

Within the half-term, we will be learning about realistic goals and the strengths as learners and resisting distractions. The children will also be learning how to recognise right and wrong and the differences between sensible and nonsensible behaviours.

## Science / Outdoor Education

This term the children will be exploring everyday materials. The children will identify and name a variety of materials including glass, metal and rock. We will also be describing simple physical properties of everyday materials and compare and group together a variety of everyday materials.
