

Computing

This term, the children will be learning about networks and the internet. The children will learn how we are connected digitally, who owns websites and what the internet is made of.

Art

The children will be exploring the artwork of JMW Turner exploring his painting of a volcano eruption. The children will be using this as a stimulus to create their own collage of a volcano eruption using natural resources.



Spanish

Within Spanish this term the children will be learning about key classroom language. The children will then move on to learning the nouns of animals and how to make them plural as well.

English

The children will be writing their own persuasive letters including a variety of new skills such as using: emotive language, statistics and rule of three in order to persuade. We will also be writing an adventure story where the children will have to create characters with a descriptive setting, plot, problem, resolution and ending.



Year 3 Curriculum Map Spring 1

Maths

In maths the children will be exploring geometry. The children will be learning about different types of angles, being able to identify them within shapes but also being able to compare angles. Alongside this, we will continue with our work on number using formal written methods for multiplication and division.

Geography

The children will be starting a new unit of work - The Active World. As part of this topic, the children will be exploring different physical features around the world including volcanoes, earthquakes and the environment. Locating cities, seas and rivers. We will also be exploring relief maps and looking at the equator and northern and southern hemispheres.



Music

The children will be learning to sing with good technique using the skills of clear diction a range of dynamics and pitch. They will be learning to perform songs about volcanoes.

Physical Education

The children will be learning gymnastics and net and court games this half term. In gymnastics, we will look at balancing and creating different shapes whilst balancing. In net and court games, we will explore agility, balance and co-ordination skills needed for games such as tennis.



RESPECT

Within respect this term, the children will be learning about the importance of setting themselves goals and making decisions. We will also look at the emotion of empathy and how to be kind to others.

Science / Outdoor Education

Year 3 will be learn more about animals including humans. We will start by focusing on the human element of this exploring the human body by looking at the skeleton and how muscles work. We will also be exploring how to maintain a healthy diet.
