

Computing

This term, the children will be learning how to edit photographs. The children will focus on cropping, re-colouring and cloning to create a Bayeux Tapestry inspired artwork.

Art

In art, we will be exploring the works of the Bayeux Tapestry. We will be learning about the history behind the tapestry and the historical artists who created it. We will draw and sketch animals and people in our own section.



Spanish

In Spanish, we will be learning about shapes and describing the position of shapes. We will additionally be learning the correct names for body parts.

English

This half-term our focus text will be Macbeth. During this unit we will learn about the life of William Shakespeare. We will first be focusing on writing play scripts using the correct structure and dialogue continuing to use adverbs to convey verbs effectively. Then we will move onto writing informal letters. Our non-fiction writing focus will be a newspaper report. In reading, we will be continuing to learn inference skills. We will also learn how to identify the main ideas in a text and how to summarise these.



Year 4 Curriculum Map Spring 1

Maths

During this half term, we will be continuing learning about fractions and strategies for multiplication and division. We will be focusing on the relationships between decimals and fractions. We will then move onto statistics where we will collect and represent continuous data in a line graph.

History

In history, we are learning about Anglo-Saxon Britain. They will be able to understand why the Romans left Britain and how the Anglo-Saxons successfully invaded. We will examine and artefacts found locally and discuss what they tell us about life then. We will explore the significance of Saint Cuthbert.

Science / Outdoor Education

This half-term, Year 4 are looking at states of matter. The children will learn about the different states of matter – solids, gases and liquids. They will also learn about temperature and the changes between the states. We will also begin to explore the water cycle.

Physical Education

The Children will be doing gymnastics and invasion games this half term. In gymnastics, we will look at further developing balancing and travelling skills. We will then use these skills to create a short sequence combining, travel, balances and shapes. In invasion games we will look at passing accurately and moving into space in a game.

In Respect, we will be focusing on understanding ourselves as a learner and taking responsibility for our actions at home and school. Additionally, we will be learning about making decisions and how these can impact others.

Music

In music, we will be explore how images can be created by music. We will then plan, create and perform a class composition.
