## **Computing**

This term, the children will be learning how to use Spreadsheets in Microsoft Excel. They will learn how to collect and input data, how to format a worksheet and how to use formulas to calculate.

## **English**

This half term, the children will be introduced to their new topic – WW2. They will be reading the following books: The Boy in Striped Pyjamas, Goodnight Mr Tom and Carrie's War. The children will be writing informal letters focusing on the main events of their set texts. The children will use structural and language features to form their letters.

In Grammar, the children will recap apostrophes for possession and contractions, semi-colons progressive and perfect tenses.

## **Science / Outdoor Education**

This term, Year 6 will be learning all things electricity
They will be identifying insulators and
conductors. They will learn how to represent a simple
circuit in a diagram using recognized symbols.
Children will build circuits for specific purposes and to
investigate what happens when they change
components in a circuit.

### Maths
