Computing

This term, the children will be completing digital art using the software Microsoft Paint. We will learn how to select appropriate tools and make careful decisions.

Design Technology

In D&T this term, the children will be making a toy for the Incredibles character Jack-Jack. They will make the moving toy based on a design brief.

After they have made their toy, they will evaluate their design and the design process.

Phonics

We will continue to learn and recap the set 2 and set 3 sounds. These consist of two or three letters which represent one sound or letters that are split between a consonant.

a-e, o-e, tion, cious, ph, wh. The children will also be exposed to a variety of alien words relating to the sounds they are learning and recapping.

English

Over this half-term, the children will be introduced to instructions. Building up to writing their instructions, the children will be learning and understanding imperative verbs and using time adverbs to order instructions that they can use in their own instructions making porridge. In addition, the children will also understand a story and retrieve and infer information from the story 'The Large Family- All in one piece' to be able to write a recount about the story they have read.

Maths

Over this term, we will be focusing on solving problems that involve using balance to compare two or four objects to find out which is heavier and arranging them in ascending order of weight. The children will also measure to record lengths, heights, weight and volume, using standard and non-standard units.

Geography

This term, the children will be focussing on the topic 'We are Britain' The children will be identifying where the UK is on a map and they will be looking at the countries that create the UK as well as the surrounding seas.



Music

The focus in music this half-term is sound. The children will perform their sound journeys and adding movement to the songs they have created. In addition, the children will create sound effects and create a composition.

Physical Education

This half term the children will continue to develop their ball skills. Pupils will now experiment linking the ball skills learnt with movement. Pupils will also start dance and look at basic dance actions such as travel and gestures in the themes of storytime.

RESPECT

Within the half-term, we will be learning about realistic goals and the strengths as learners and resisting distractions. The children will also be learning how to recognise right and wrong and the differences between sensible and nonsensible behaviours.

Science / Outdoor Education

This term, the children will be learning about plants. They will look at identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants. The children will also describe the basic structure of a variety of common plants, including trees.

Over this half term, the children will be learning how different religions celebrate and demonstrate being courageous and confident and how to be loyal and steadfast.
