

Computing

This term, the children will be making digital music using software such as Google Music Labs. The children will learn about rhythms and tempo to make Habitat focussed based sounds.

Design Technology

In D&T this term, the children will be making a free-standing throne for the Head Girl/Boy. They will make the throne based on a design brief. After they have made their throne, they will evaluate their design and the design process.

Guided Reading

This half term, the children will be focusing on a range of comprehension reading skills. Year 2, will be linking question types to all reading skills such as inferring, retrieving and predicting and understanding which skill to apply. The children will also be making links with the book they are reading to book they have already read.

English

This half term, Year 2 will be focusing on writing a non-chronological report about Jamaica which is linked to their Wider Curriculum topic about commonwealth countries. Within their reports, they will also include specific punctuation marks; such as exclamation marks and question marks. The children will also include the use of subordination and co-ordination to extend sentences and add detail.

Maths

During this half term, Year 2 will be focusing on missing number equations and learning the skill of inverse. Understanding that the inverse of addition is subtraction, and the inverse of multiplication is division. The children will then be learning how to multiple and divide.

Geography

During this term, the children will be conducting an international study on the country of Jamaica. The children will be exploring where Jamaica is along with what it would be like to live in Jamaica exploring the climate and human and physical features that can be found there.



Music

This term, Year 2 will be learning to explore how ways sounds are organised and compose their own piece of music. The children will then perform the piece of music that they have composed.

Physical Education

During this half term pupils will continue to develop their FMS in small games with a focus on dribbling, hitting and kicking. Pupils will also start dance with the theme of ballroom/medieval dancing in the ugly bug ball.



RESPECT

This term, the children will be learning about Individual liberty - Mutual Respect. Through this, the children will learn how to set goals, take responsibility, make decisions. Year 2 will also explore global issues affecting children.

Religious Education

This half term, the children will be identifying how different religions and beliefs show care for others, animals and the environment. They will also be exploring how different religions demonstrate being merciful and forgiving.

Science / Outdoor Education

This term, the children will be learning about the lifestyle of animals, including offspring that grow into adults. The children will also be identifying the basic needs of the animals for survival. They children will also look at the effects of exercise and diet on the human body.
