Computing

This term, the children will be creating videos using iPads about the Trojan Horse Invasion. They will learn about filming techniques and how to edit videos using Microsoft Video Editor.

English

Linking to the topic of Ancient Greece, children will be focusing on the book 'Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief' to create a newspaper report about the events on the Golden Gate.

In Grammar, the children will be focusing on present perfect tense, brackets for parenthesis and dashes.

In Reading, we will be focusing on the skills of prediction, retrieval, inference, vocabulary, summarising, text structure and also comparing and contrasting.

Geography

Mountains will be the focus of the Geographical learning this term for Year 5. The children will be exploring how different mountains are formed and what their features are. The children will go on to compare significant UK mountains with others that can be found all around the world.

We will be looking into setting goals and challenges, taking responsibility and exploring decision making.

Design Technology

In D&T this term, the children will create a recipe and choose ingredients based on their Nutrional values to make a Greek flatbread. They will then safely prepare the ingredients and make their flat bread. After they have made this, they will evaluate their meal and the design process.

Music

We will be focusing on analysing music by considering sounds produced and comparing and contrasting to other pieces.

Religious Education

During this half term, the children will be exploring and identifying how different religions show participation and willing to lead. They will also be being learning about being modest and listening to others is incorporated in different religions.

Spanish

Within Spanish this term, the children will be learning about sports. They will learn how to discuss what sports they play and give their opinions on different sports. They will also learn about pronouns.

Maths

This half term, we will be focusing on conversions. This will be within measurement, in particular length, mass and capacity. We will also consider the skill of conversion within money problems and apply to a variety of problem-solving money questions.

Physical Education

Pupils will be starting hockey this term. Pupils will re-cap and practise the basic dribbling technique and learn to change direction to avoid obstacles. Attacking and defending methods will be introduced to pupils and they will start to play competitive games using the basic quickstick rules. In Year 5, will challenge their balance, agility, and coordination further by incorporating exercises that require them to move quickly and smoothly on the Bosu. They will engage in activities that involve both static and dynamic balancing, such as balancing on the Bosu while passing a ball or performing a series of quick movements like lunges or jumps.

Science / Outdoor Education

This half term, Year 5 will begin their science unit on properties and changes of materials.

They will be identifying reversible and irreversible materials and testing solids, liquids and gases to identify conductivity and solubility.
