Computing

This term, the children will be completing digital writing. They will be exploring how to create, edit and modify text to change its content, size and appearance through effective use of a toolbar.

English

Over this half-term, the children will be introduced to instructions. Building up to writing their instructions, the children will be learning and understanding about imperative verbs and using time adverbs to order instructions that they can use in their own instructions making porridge. In addition, the children will also understand a story and retrieve and infer information from the story 'The Large Family- All in one piece' to be able to write a recount about the story they have read.

Religious Education

This half term children will be focussing on remembering roots and Being Hopeful and Visionary. Children will be linking these dispositions to religions and identifying different stories demonstrate these.

RESPECT

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Within the half-term, the children will explore people that are important to them. They will also understand that communities have a wide range of different people of all ages and learn specific area of needs.

<u>Art</u>

In Art this half term, the children will be creating a seaside scene using 3D paper sculpting. They will be learning about different paper folding techniques to create a piece of art.

<u>Music</u>

This half-term the children will be using drums. The children will explore playing a pulse and keeping it. Once the children are able to keep a pulse, they will listen to and analyse music, singing songs at the correct pitch.

History

Children in Year 1 will discuss significant events and people in Britian within and beyond my living memory. Also, the children will place significant events and objects in chronological order.

Phonics

We will continue to learn and recap the set 2 and set 3 sounds. These consist of two or three letters which represent one sound or letters that are split between a consonant. a-e, o-e, tion, cious, ph, wh The children will also be exposed to a variety of alien words relating to the sounds they are learning and recapping.

Maths

Over this term, we will be focus on doubling using pictorial representations, number sentences and doubling problems. In addition, the children will draw arrays to represent repeated addition and multiplication. The children will then move on to fractions, exploring grouping and sharing equally with accuracy and identifying fractions of amounts in shapes.

Physical Education

This half term the children will be linking their object control and locomotion skills that they have learnt previously together to perform skills of greater difficulty. For example: Pupils will link the skill of catching a bouncing ball whilst moving to perform the skill of dribbling.

Science / Outdoor Education

This term, the children will begin their unit of seasonal changes. They will observe changes across all four of the seasons, describing the weather associated with each season and how day length varies between them. The children will be relating weather patterns and day length to seasons. And make and test predictions relating to changing day length and weather patterns.
