

Computing

This term, the children will be learning all about stop-frame animation. They will understand how still images can be manipulated to create the appearance of movement within a story.

Art

As a part of our Ancient Egypt unit of work the children will be creating their own Egyptian sarcophagus lid out of clay. They will be learning skills of shaping and moulding and then using clay tools to inscribe detail.

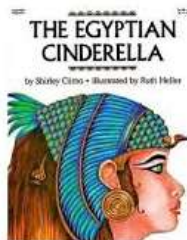


Spanish

Within Spanish, the children will be learning about different foods. They will then learn about the story of the hungry caterpillar and how to retell the story.

English

Within the summer term, the children will be developing their language skills by learning about metaphors. This is a feature that they will be including when they write a character description about the Egyptian Cinderella - the topic book that the children will be reading. The children will later in the term go on to learn about narrative poetry and write one about the death of an Egyptian Pharaoh.



Year 3 Curriculum Map Summer 1

Maths

In maths, year 3 will be recording measurements using mixed units such as grams and kilograms, metres and centimetres and litres and millilitres. The children will also add, subtract, measure and compare length, mass and volume. They will also develop their understanding of grid references and position and direction by programming beebots to follow a route.

Religious Education.

This half term, the children will be focusing on the dispositions: Being Open, Honest and Truth and Being Attentive to the sacred as well as the precious. Children will be using different religious stories to identify the dispositions and how different religions link to these.

Music

This half term, the children will be creating a musical piece based inspired by stories on the Ancient Egyptians. The children will analyse and create rhythms using a mix of tuned and untuned instrument. The children will then discuss how the music captures each element of the story/character.

Physical Education

This Half term pupils will be introduced to striking and fielding. We will recap the correct technique for under and overarm throws and start to understand when it is appropriate to use each one. Pupils will experiment striking a ball with a variety of bats for example rounders and cricket.



RESPECT

This half term the children will be exploring the 'relate' module of MyHappyMind. The children will focus on how to develop good listening skills, the importance of listening to others, and what we can learn when we listen to others.

History

The children this term will be diving into the world of Ancient Egypt. They will be examining artefacts, looking at the process of mumification. They will also be looking at the importance of gods and goddesses during that time period.

Science / Outdoor Education

This half term, the children will begin their units on forces. They will compare how different objects move on different surfaces. The children will also observe how magnets attract and repel each other and attract some materials and not others. We will be carrying out an experiment and grouping materials based on whether or not they are magnetic.
