

Computing

This term, the children will be learning to using repetition in codes on Scratch. The children will begin by creating basic loops and progress into deigning, creating and finalising their own looping game.

Art

In art, we will be exploring the works of the Banksy and graffiti art. They will use different types of pencil to create different lines.



Spanish

In Spanish, we will be learning about family and names for different members of family. We will additionally be learning to give descriptions in Spanish.

English

This half-term our focus text will be Oliver Twist. During this unit, we will learn about the structure of mystery stories and use the language devices we have learnt about throughout the year to enhance our own mystery stories. We will then be learning about discussion texts and be focusing on comparative adverbials. In reading, we will be continuing to learn inference, prediction and summarising skills using the Oliver Twist text. In Grammar, we will be focusing on possessive apostrophes, linking ideas paragraphs, prefixes and suffixes.



Year 4 Curriculum Map Summer 1

Maths

During this half term, we will be focusing on measure. We will begin by converting units of measure and solving problems involving length, mass and capacity. Then, we will move on to learning about time. We will focus on converting time between analogue and digital 12- and 24- hour clocks. Additionally, we will be calculating the duration of events and solving problems.

Religious Education.

This half term, children will be learning about the following dispositions: Living by rules and Being Temperate, Self-Disciplined and Seeking Contentment. Children will be identifying how different religions have different rules and why.



Music

In music, we will be exploring musical terms, listening to and analysing music and then composing our own music in groups to perform to the rest of the class.

Physical Education

This term pupils will focus on athletics. We will learn the correct technique to throw a javelin, sprint and run longer distances. Pupils will also start to learn about pacing and experiment what pace to use for different distances. We will continue to explore different footwork patterns when jumping.



RESPECT

In Respect, we will be focusing on discussing relationships we have with important people in our life. We will also be learning about different community groups and the differences in their experiences.

History

In history, we are learning about Crime and Punishment. We will be identifying and describing changes between specific periods of history and learning about how we know about historic crime and punishments.

Science / Outdoor Education

This half-term, Year 4 are learning about Electricity. We will be identifying common appliances that run on electricity and comparing appliances that run on mains electricity with those that run on batteries. We will be constructing simple series circuits, identifying and naming parts. We will be learning about conductors and insulators.
