Computing

This term, the children will be programming variables in games using Scratch. They will learn how to add score counters to their programmes and how to improve their games.

English

This half term, children will be exploring the narrative poem, 'The Highwayman'. Children will begin by looking at the features of the poem and the meaning of the words. Children will then consider the differing points of views of the different characters. They will then take this knowledge to create a persuasive letter by focusing on persuasive devices, cause and effect sentences and parenthesis.

Religious Education

This half term, Children will be learning about Being Temperate, Self-Disciplined and Seeking Contentment and Being Accountable and Living with Integrity. Children will be discussing how different religions incorporate these dispositions into their practice.




My Happy Mind

We will be looking at changes, democracy and collective responsibility.

<u>Art</u>

As a part of our British Empire unit of work the children will be designing and creating their own block printing tile. They will be learning how to create layers of paint to add detail to background colour.

<u>Music</u>

We will be exploring sound sources by looking at repeated phrases, percussion loop accompaniment and sequenced sounds.

History

This term, we will be exploring British Empire. We will understand abstract terms such as empire, civilisation, parliament and peasantry. We look at analysing the different reasons that Britain wanted to grow an expire and will look at different events and accounts that led to the development and eventual fall of the British Empire.

<u>Spanish</u>

Within Spanish this term, the children will be learning about sports . They will learn how to discuss what sports they play and give their opinions on different sports, They will also learn about pronouns.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term, we will be focusing on reading, sorting, interpreting and representing data using a range of charts, diagrams and tables. We will also be looking at time problems.

Physical Education

Pupils will be moving onto tennis this half term. We will re-cap and practice the tennis strokes learnt in Year 4. Pupils will then start to use these tennis strokes to perform a rally with a partner over a net.

Science / Outdoor Education

This term, Year 5 will be focusing on the life cycles of plants and animals, understanding the life cycles of plants and their pollination process. In particular, the children will describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
