

Computing

This term, the children will be learning about technology in the classroom. The children will also be learning about using technology and developing their keyboard and mouse skills.

Art

Year 1 will develop their ideas through exploring different ways of line work such as dots, dashes, faint lines and bold lines. The children will also be mixing primary colours to create secondary colours and creating different thickness of paint by adding water.

Phonics

Year 1 will be consolidating the Phase 2 initial sounds taught in Reception. They will review Phase 3 digraphs including ai ee igh oa oo ar or ur oo ow oi and ear.

English

This half term, Year 1 will be reading The Gingerbread man. The children will retell the story and use adjectives to describe an object. In addition, the children will continue to consolidate their letter formation of lower-case letters in the correct direction and form capital letters correctly.

Maths

During this half term, the children will be focusing on place value. They will begin to memorise number bonds to 10 and 20. In addition, the children will count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. They will learn to identify one more and one less and identify and represent numbers using pictorial representations.

Physical Education

In P.E, children will be developing their fundamental and locomotion skills. Pupils will learn how to travel in different ways such as jumping, skipping, walking, leaping and hopping. Pupils will begin gymnastics where they will explore balancing on different body parts and in different shapes.



Music

This half term, the children will be focusing on playing simple rhythms and to sing songs using body percussion.

History

In Year 1, children will be thinking about how memories and the past can be explored. They will investigate the history of the local area, finding out what stood here before our school and comparing similarities and differences over time. Pupils will also practise using key words and phrases linked to the passing of time, while asking and answering questions about photographs, films, artefacts and maps.

RESPECT

Within this half term, Year 1 will be learning about belonging, feeling safe and content and making the classroom a safe place. They will also be learning about belonging and feeling safe and content.



Science

This term's topic is animals including humans. They will learn to identify parts of the human body and identify our different senses. Children will learn about healthy eating and identify different food groups which are healthier than others.
